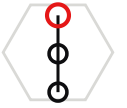


The AI Toolkit.

Six tools we reach for every day — what each one actually does, and the moment to use it.

Automate the busywork. Spend the time on what matters.



Process Interviewer

Get the whole thing clear before a single line is built.

WHAT IT DOES

Before you build anything complex, it sits you down and asks the right questions — one at a time — until the whole thing is crystal clear. Then it hands you a structured summary, and a full brief if you're building a skill.

USE IT WHEN

- You want to create a skill, workflow, automation or system but haven't nailed down the details.
- You catch yourself saying "I want to build X" but you're fuzzy on the how.
- You're starting something big and know that jumping straight in usually ends in rework.

SKIP IT WHEN

The task is small and you already know exactly what you want.



Humanizer

Same meaning, none of the robotic filler.

WHAT IT DOES

Takes text that smells like AI — generic openers, inflated buzzwords, robotic symmetry — and rewrites it so it sounds like an actual person wrote it. Keeps the meaning, cuts the filler.

USE IT WHEN

- You wrote or generated an email, post, sales message or web copy and it sounds too polished.
- A client or boss says “this reads like ChatGPT.”
- You want something direct and believable instead of corporate fluff.

GOOD TO KNOW

It won't change your facts, numbers or promises — just the tone and phrasing.



Prompt Optimizer

Shapes half-formed ideas into prompts that actually work.

WHAT IT DOES

Turns messy ideas, half-baked notes or voice dictations into clean, structured prompts ready to paste into any AI tool. It even adapts the format to whether you're targeting Claude, Midjourney, Sora, n8n and the rest.

USE IT WHEN

- You have an idea in your head but your prompt keeps giving mediocre results.
- You're dictating something messy and want it shaped into a proper instruction.
- You're prompting image, video or automation tools and don't know the right structure.

BONUS

You don't even have to say the word "prompt" — any idea that needs structuring triggers it.



Visual Presentations

A wall of text becomes a deck with a real narrative.

WHAT IT DOES

Builds modern, self-contained HTML presentations from an idea, a document, a transcript or an existing PowerPoint. One file, opens in any browser, with proper design and a clear narrative arc.

USE IT WHEN

- You need a deck for a meeting, class, pitch, training or video.
- You've got a wall of text or a rough outline and want it turned into clean slides.
- You want to upgrade an ugly existing presentation without rebuilding from scratch.

HANDY DETAIL

It adapts the layout: big bold slides for video, denser content for training sessions.



Superpowers

Senior-professional mode for anything with moving parts.

WHAT IT DOES

Flips you into “senior professional” mode for anything complex. Instead of rushing to execute, it forces a proper sequence: understand → plan → spot risks → define quality → build → review.

USE IT WHEN

- You’re building or modifying something with multiple moving parts — an app, a system, a strategy.
- You say “just do everything” but the requirements aren’t fully defined.
- The task could go wrong in several ways and you want it done right the first time.

THINK OF IT AS

The opposite of “move fast and break things.” It’s “think first, then move fast.”



Fact-Checker

A verdict on every claim before it goes out.

WHAT IT DOES

Reviews any text for claims that are wrong, exaggerated or impossible to verify, then gives you a classified report — correct, exaggerated, incorrect — with suggested fixes and a final publish / don't-publish verdict.

USE IT WHEN

- You're about to publish a post, script, article or report and want to catch errors first.
- Your text quotes stats, dates, prices or features that might be outdated.
- You're making claims about AI tools, competitors or anything health, finance or legal.

REASSURING PART

It marks what it can't verify as "unverifiable", and won't touch opinions unless you dressed them up as facts.



Pick your tool

Start from what you want to get done.
